## MAINTENANCE TIPS

### Energy-Saving Tips for Your Home

Reducing energy use not only lowers your utility bills but also helps the environment. Here are some easy ways to save:

- **Switch to LED Bulbs.** LED lights use up to 80% less energy than traditional bulbs and last much longer.
- **Unplug Unused Electronics.** Devices like chargers, TVs, and gaming consoles still draw power when plugged in. Unplug them when not in use.
- **Wash Clothes in Cold Water.** Heating water accounts for a large portion of energy use in laundry. Cold washes are just as effective for most loads.
- **Run Full Loads in Dishwashers and Washers.** Maximize efficiency by waiting until you have a full load before running these appliances.
- **Take Advantage of Natural Light.** Open curtains during the day to reduce the need for artificial lighting.
- **Maintain HVAC Systems.** Clean or replace filters regularly and schedule seasonal tune-ups to keep systems running efficiently. You can pick up free filters at Self Help!
