COMMUNITY NEWS: ON GOING ROAD REPAVING ON RADFORD & HALSEY

Dear Residents,

We want to keep everyone informed about the ongoing road repaving project in Radford and Halsey. This work is part of an effort to improve roadway conditions, enhance safety, and provide a smoother driving experience for our community.

What to Expect:

- Active construction zones may be present in either Radford or Halsey throughout the project.
- Temporary lane closures or traffic detours may occur depending on daily work schedules.
- Increased noise and construction activity during normal working hours.
- Parking restrictions may be in place in certain areas while crews are working.

How This Affects You:

- Please use caution when driving or walking through construction areas.
- Follow posted signage and any directions from construction crews.
- Allow extra time for travel in and around Radford and Halsey during work hours.

We understand that road work can be inconvenient. We truly appreciate your patience and cooperation during this improvement project. Once complete, these updates will result in safe, better-quality roads for everyone in the neighborhood. IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING FERAL CHICKENS IN OUR NEIGHBORHOODS

Feral chickens are a health hazard and nuisance in our communities. These wild birds are descendants of birds that were once in captivity, but are believed, due to windstorms, to have escaped and multiplied, now causing a real challenge for Ohana Navy Family Housing to control them in our neighborhoods.

They create nuisances by foraging in residential areas, crowing at inconvenient hours, posing health concerns with their waste, and agitating household pets. More roaming chickens mean more nuisances. **We would like to request if you find a nest of eggs in your neighborhood or private backyard area to please report its location to Ohana Navy Family Housing so we can remove the eggs.** This is the easiest way to control our feral chicken population. We also request feral chickens not be fed by our Residents.

Please keep in mind that while the chicks are cute, they will grow up and multiply, and 50% of those chicks will become roosters! Please support us in our efforts to reduce feral chicken populations by not feeding birds and reporting nests with eggs. Together we can promote a safer and quieter neighborhood.
