- 1. Prevent Drain Clogs:** Keep your drains flowing by avoiding grease, coffee grounds, and food scraps in the sink. These materials can harden and cause blockages. Instead, use a strainer to catch debris and dispose of waste in the trash.
- 2. Report Maintenance Issues Early:** If you notice a small issue, like a slow drain, minor leak, or damaged fixture, submit a service request right away through the resident portal or app. Addressing problems early helps prevent larger, more costly repairs later.
