Are you moving soon? Here is the Notice to Vacate Process:

If you and your family are preparing to move, please remember that **Ohana Navy Family Housing requires a written 28-day Notice to Vacate**, along with a copy of your **PCS/ETS/Retirement Orders (if applicable)**.

Notices submitted with fewer than 28 days may result in financial responsibility for the remaining notice period.



How to Submit Your 28-Day Notice to Vacate

- **Visit your Resident Services Office (RSO):** Notify staff in person and, if available, bring a copy of your Orders. Your RSO will schedule your pre-inspection and final inspection.
- **Call or Email Your RSO:** Call (808) 784-7800 (Option 2) or email your Resident Services Office to **receive a DocuSign Notice to Vacate** for signature.

Short Notice Orders

If you receive short-notice Orders that do not allow for a full 28-day notice, you may be exempt from financial responsibility if you provide:

- A written Notice to Vacate
- A letter from your Commander validating the short notice
- A copy of your Orders
- Approval from the Community Director

For questions or assistance, please contact your Resident Services Office. We're here to help make your move as smooth as possible.

Maintenance tips for plumbing and water care: Please report leaks such as dripping faucets, running toilets, and water under the sink immediately as this will help us avoid further damage and repair.

Additional Helpful Tips

- Do not pour grease or food scraps down the drain. Wipe pans before washing.
- Use drain strainers to prevent clogs in sinks and showers.
- Run bathroom fans during showers to reduce moisture and mildew.

Bring a plant to swap with a neighbor. Also, pick up a packet of seeds to start a new garden. Decorate a small pot for your new plant!

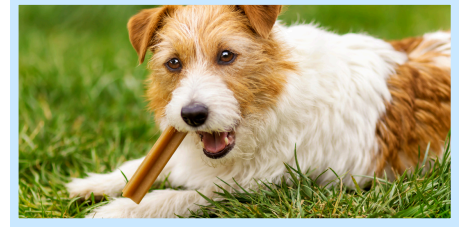


PAWS AND APPLAUSE DOG WALK
